

## SHOW ME YOUR GLORY

Exodus 33:12 Moses' anxious plea.

vs. 14 & 17

Vs. 11 Moses can ask for anything. What does he ask for?

Moses knew what God \_\_\_\_\_ do.

Knew what the people were \_\_\_\_\_ to do.

God is ready to be done with them. Moses pleads, twice. 32:11-14 and vs. 31 & 32.

Moses' prayer \_\_\_\_\_ God's heart.

Yet another request, vs. 18 "Show me your glory."
